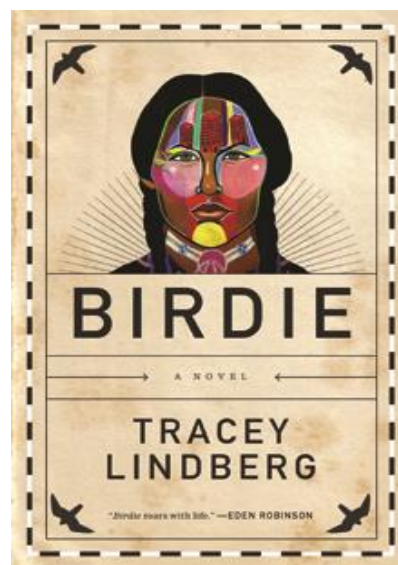
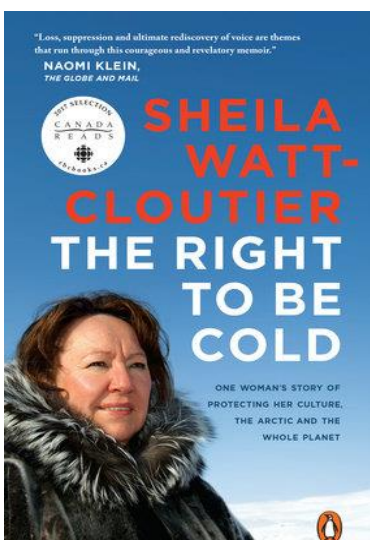
## Book discussions
